

Bylaw on use of Marine Laboratory at Center for Marine Environment Studies (enacted on July 27th, 2004).

(Objectives)

Article 1 In accordance with Article 15.7 of the Regulation of Center for Marine Environment Studies (enacted on April 1, 2004, hereinafter referred to as "Center Regulations"), the Bylaw hereby stipulates provisions relevant to use of Marine Laboratory (hereinafter referred to as "Laboratory").

(Users of Laboratory)

Article 2 Those who may use Laboratory are as follows:

- 1); faculty members or students of Kumamoto University (hereinafter referred to as "University") for the purpose of research or education.
- 2); groups or individuals not belonging to University for above-mentioned purposes with permission from the Director of Center for Marine Environment Studies (hereinafter referred to as "Director").
- 3). persons with special permission from Director.

(Application for use)

Article 3 Those wishing to use Laboratory shall submit an application (given in appendix 1st) to Director at least ten days before the beginning of use.

(Special case for rental fee)

Article 4 The following persons shall not be charged rental fee prescribed in Article 15.5 of Regulation.

- 1); faculty members or students of University for the purpose of research or education on marine environment,
- 2); persons engaged in research or education jointly with staff of Center with special permissions from Director,
- 3). persons with special permission from Director.

(Extension of period)

Article 5 In case of Laboratory use beyond the stipulated research or education periods, permission for period extension from Director shall be necessary in advance.

2. Those given the above-mentioned permission shall make a payment for rent immediately; provided, however, the person is not among those stipulated in Article 4.

(Cancellation of permission to use)

Article 6 Director shall cancel the permission to use, or stop the use of Laboratory under any of the following circumstances:

- 1); misstatements in the application form,
- 2). and disobedience to instructions of staff of Center.

2. Center shall not be responsible for damages caused from cancellations or discontinuances of Laboratory-use.

(Use of equipments and instruments)

Article 7 Concerning the persons applied to Article 2.2, groups or individuals not engaged in research or education jointly with staff of Center shall bring their necessary instruments by themselves; provided, however, that the use of installed equipments in Center may be especially permitted by Director.

(Restoration to original state)

Article 8 In case of loss or damages of equipments or instruments made by users

intentionally or negligently, the users shall restore them to their original state under orders from Director.

(Miscellaneous)

Article 9 Besides the Bylaw, Director may separately stipulate additional provisions related to Laboratory-use.

Supplementary provision

The bylaw shall be applied on April 1st, 2004, and enforced on July 27th, 2004.
